Action Plan Actions:

Each Theme Lead negotiates with delivery partners to agree details of Actions, and then monitors and reports on Actions in that theme. Action Plan was released end November, progress delayed ...

Each Action has a 'Lead Delivery Partner' to coordinate with 'Other Delivery Partner(s)' (if any).

First reporting period ends March 2014 - progress reporting to July meeting of RCCP Board.

Action Plan to be reviewed and revised annually.

What are Actions?

In all cases RCCP want to monitor that best practice is followed and good progress is being made ... and understand the barriers to improvement

T1SP4.8 - Encourage local communities and businesses to support the development of renewable energy in their communities. (RBC lead partner)

- GREN encouraged RCCP to commission a report from TVE on prospects of Hydro at Reading Weir - awaited.
- Report on Hydro by Brendan Barrow now on GREN website.
- RFoE held public meeting on variability of renewable energy in January 2014 - was publicised via media and posters.
- No detailed guidance yet from RBC
- What else can we do?

T8SP1.2 - Build relationships with 'non-environmental groups'; encourage uptake of sustainable community related activities through a 'campaign' ... (RCCP lead organisation)

- There will be an article about TTR's DraughtBusters in a local churches magazine Xn.
- Reading Rotary Club have been encouraged to support the TTR's DraughtBusters scheme.
- GREN applied to join Reading Neighbourhood Network
- No detailed guidance yet from RCCP
- What else can we do?

T8SP1.3 - Sustain and improve 'environmental' community organisations by improving links between groups contributing to tackling climate change. (RCCP as Lead)

- GREN Website and Facebook continue active
- GREN Members' Meeting 1st March 2014
- TTR DraughtBusters active over winter 2013/14
- Reading Sustainability Centre proposals Jan-Mar 2014
- No detailed guidance yet from RCCP
- What else can we do?

T8SP2.1 - Build uptake of energy efficiency, renewable energy & energy co-ops as well as (communal) food growing. Engage appropriate asset holders and develop local schemes. (RBC as lead)

- TTR and DraughtBusters have acted and have an ongoing programme including seminars, training and delivery. This has now moved into consulting with other organisations in other towns wanting to do similar things.
- No detailed guidance yet from RBC.
- What else can we do?

T8SP3.3 - Build 'share and repair' movement, increasing skills in the community and reducing waste. (TT Reading as Lead)

- Repair Café started October 2013 as joint GREN/TTR initiative - now run monthly by TTR and Hackspace, alternating venues.
- No detailed guidance yet from TTR
